

The Jackson County Trail Riders Club Welcomes You to Crawford Hills!

The Jackson County Trail Riders maintain over 30 miles of single-track motorcycle trails at Crawford Hills County Park located 13 miles east of Black River Falls, Wis. The trails are open from May 15 through the last Sunday of October.

All riders using the Crawford Hills motorcycle trail system are required to purchase a Jackson County motorcycle sticker prior to operating on the trails. The cost is \$20 for an annual sticker.

Motorcycle stickers can be ordered online at www.jacksoncountyparks.us/parks. Look for the Permits & Products tab. Motorcycle stickers are also available at several local businesses listed on our website at jacksoncountytrailriders.com.

The trails are open to both street legal and off-road motorcycles. The ATV trails are limited to street legal motorcycles driven by licensed operators. Off-road bike riders can use the ATV connector route to travel between trails.

Exhaust systems exceeding the noise of the original equipment of your bike are prohibited. Spark arresters are required.

There are three trails: the North Loop, the South Loop and the McKenna Loop. Detailed maps of each loop can be found on the club's website.

Please stay on the marked trails and ride only in the direction indicated by the arrows. The club recently installed location markers on blue posts every half mile on each of the three trails.

The club also added two Youth Loops located on the north and south sides of the campground's day-use parking area.

The campground at Crawford Hills County Park features a day-use parking lot and 18 camping spots. Camping is on a first-come, first-served basis and can fill up quickly on weekends. There is also a picnic shelter, grill, water and pit toilets.

If you park in a camping spot, be sure to fill out a registration envelope and pay the fee. See the self-registration kiosk near the park entrance for current rates. Camping fees are collected by the Jackson County ATV Club, who maintains the campground. For other lodging options, see www.exploreblackriverfalls.com.

The motorcycle trails at Crawford Hills are a public trail system; not a closed race course. Please operate in a safe manner, particularly in respect to the safety of others.

We recommend that you ride with a partner and know the name of the trail you are on. Should you need assistance while out on the trails, here are some phone numbers:
